NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICY

Upper Room Christian School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally made available to students at the school. There is no discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in either administration of education and admissions policies, or in student aid, in athletic or other programs.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

- 1) We believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired Word of God, without error in the original writings; the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men, and the divine and final authority for all Christian faith and life. (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:21)
- 2) We believe in one God, the Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19; II Corinthians 13:14)
- 3) We believe that Jesus Christ is true God and true man, having been conceived of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He died on the cross as a sacrifice for sins, according to the Scriptures. Furthermore, He arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven, where He is seated at the right hand of the Majesty on High. He is now our High Priest and Advocate with the Father. (John 1:1; Luke 2:35, I Corinthians 15: 3, 4)
- 4) We believe that the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ, and during this age, to convict men, regenerate the believing sinner, indwell, guide, instruct and empower the believer for godly living and service. (John 15:26; John 16:8) We believe in the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, with the evidence of speaking in tongues, (according to Acts 2:4) is the promise of the Father, and is available to all believers who ask. (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-8)
- 5) We believe that man was created in the image of God, but fell into sin, and is therefore lost. It is only through regeneration by the Holy Spirit can salvation and spiritual life be obtained. (Genesis 1:2; Romans 5:12)
- 6) We believe that the shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only grounds for justification and salvation for all who believe, and only such as receive Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are born of the Holy Spirit, and thus become believers. (John 3:3, John 1:12, John 3:16)
- 7) We believe that water baptism for the believer and the Lord's Supper for the believer (Communion) are ordinances to be observed by the church during this present age. They are, however, not to be regarded as the means of salvation. (Matthew 28:19; I Corinthians 11:23-26)
- 8) We believe that the true church is composed of all such persons who, through saving faith in Jesus Christ, have been born anew by the Holy Spirit, and are united together in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. (I Corinthians 12:12-14)
- 9) We Believe in the personal and imminent coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and that this "blessed hope" has vital bearing on the personal life and service of the believer. (I Thessalonians 4:13-16)
- 10) We believe in the bodily resurrection of the dead, of the believer's everlasting blessedness and joy with the Lord, of the unbeliever to judgment and everlasting, conscious punishment. (I Corinthians 15:51-54)

PARENT UNDERSTANDING AND COMMITMENT AGREEMENT

RECOGNIZING OUR PARTNERSHIP WITH UPPER ROOM CHRISTIAN SCHOOL:

- 1) We understand that it is expected that we maintain a family and church life that is consistent with the teachings of the Word of God; that we will endeavor to make Christian education effective in the life of our child so that he or she may love and serve the Lord Jesus Christ all the days of his/her life.
- 2) We recognize that Upper Room Christian School has a qualified faculty and trained staff, and that we have full confidence in their abilities to perform the educational functions due our child at their discretion. All grade placement decisions by the faculty and administration we agree to accept as final.
- 3) We agree to attend the required Parent Orientation at the beginning of school, and the first and third quarter Parent-Teacher conferences, which demonstrate our commitment to the partnership for Christian Education that we have with the school and our personal support for the academic and spiritual welfare of our child.
- 4) We understand and expect the school to exercise consistent, Biblical discipline on behalf of our child, and we will fully cooperate and accept the judgments of the faculty and administration in all such matters.
- 5) We further realize that building a strong, cooperative relationship with our child's teacher(s) and following-up at home with work assignments and godly disciplinary measures are key to the spiritual training and academic achievement of our child. Cultivating this relationship is as much our responsibility as it is the school's.
- 6) We acknowledge that the greatest responsibility we have as parents to Upper Room Christian School is to pay all of our financial obligations on or before the due dates. If we are ever unable to pay on time, we will notify the school office in advance, give a reasonable explanation for the delay, and state when the payment can be made. We further understand and agree that our child(ren) will be withdrawn from Upper Room Christian School if our tuition account becomes 3 months in arrears. We further agree to sign a promissory note for all unpaid tuition, books, supplies, or any other unpaid fees that are outstanding, up to the date of withdrawal. We further understand that all academic records (including diplomas, transcripts, test scores and letters of recommendation) will not be released to parents, other schools, colleges, the armed services or employers until all financial obligations are met. **Note:** Complete tuition payment information and financial policies are included in the re-enrollment package your received. Additional copies are available at the school office.
- 7) We agree to fulfill our obligation to insure that our child is dressed in compliance with the established school uniform, gym uniform and dress code, and that we will cooperate in training our child to respect school property, and pay for misuse or damage to the same.
- 8) We agree to support the school by gifts in addition to our tuition payments and fees, as the Lord enables; to support fund raising efforts, and to undertake volunteer duties and responsibilities for Upper Room Christian School as opportunities arise.
- 9) We realize that from time to time, children take issue with actions that they do not agree with or understand, and they are prone to criticize statements out of context. This being normal for children, we pledge that should this occur, we will not support the criticism; we will correct our child, support the school, and call in for full details at any time we have a question concerning an incident.
- 10) We further acknowledge that should any misunderstanding arise regarding any of the teaching, philosophy or policies of the church or school, we will seek to resolve the matter with the person or persons involved, or consult with the Pastor of Education to resolve these matters as quickly as possible. If irreconcilable differences continue, we will withdraw from participation in the school, without criticism or sowing discord among other parents and brethren.
- 11) We understand that if for any reason the Pastor of Education or the Administration of the school determines that we are not in compliance with the letter or the spirit of this agreement, we may be asked to withdraw our child from Upper Room Christian School, and we will comply without recourse.

As Upper Room Christian School Parents, we recognize that it is our responsibility to strive diligently toward observance of the above agreement, which we enter into voluntarily and enthusiastically, requesting admission for our child to Upper Room Christian School.
