I agree to abide by the above Standards of Conduct and other regulations expected of each student enrolled in this Christian school, and will not give the impression to students, parents or faculty that I am not in harmony with the goals, aims and standards of Upper Room Christian School. I understand that upon acceptance, I will be placed on probation to see if I can uphold these Standards of Conduct. Once accepted, I further understand that if the Administration determines that I am not in harmony with the objectives and Standards of Conduct for Upper Room Christian School students, I will be dismissed from this school.
